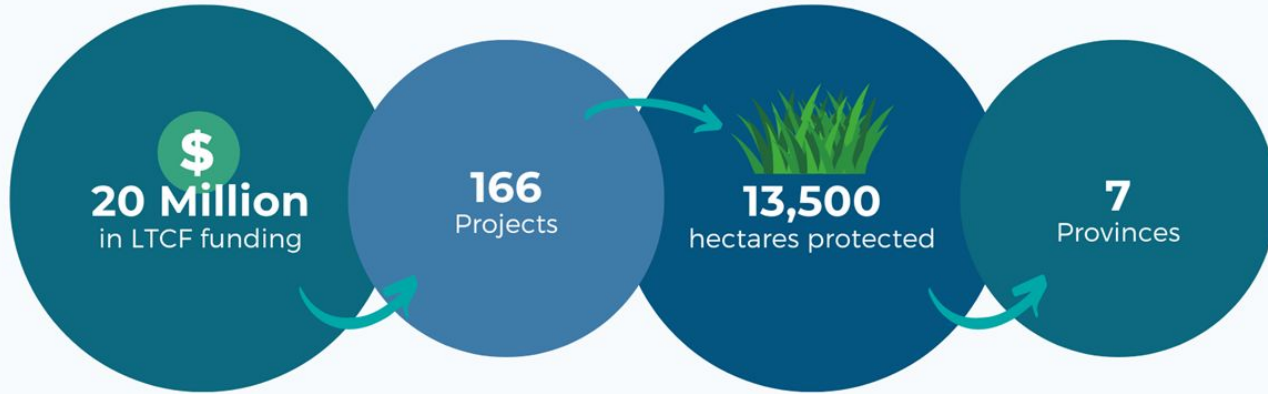

Who is Eligible to Apply?

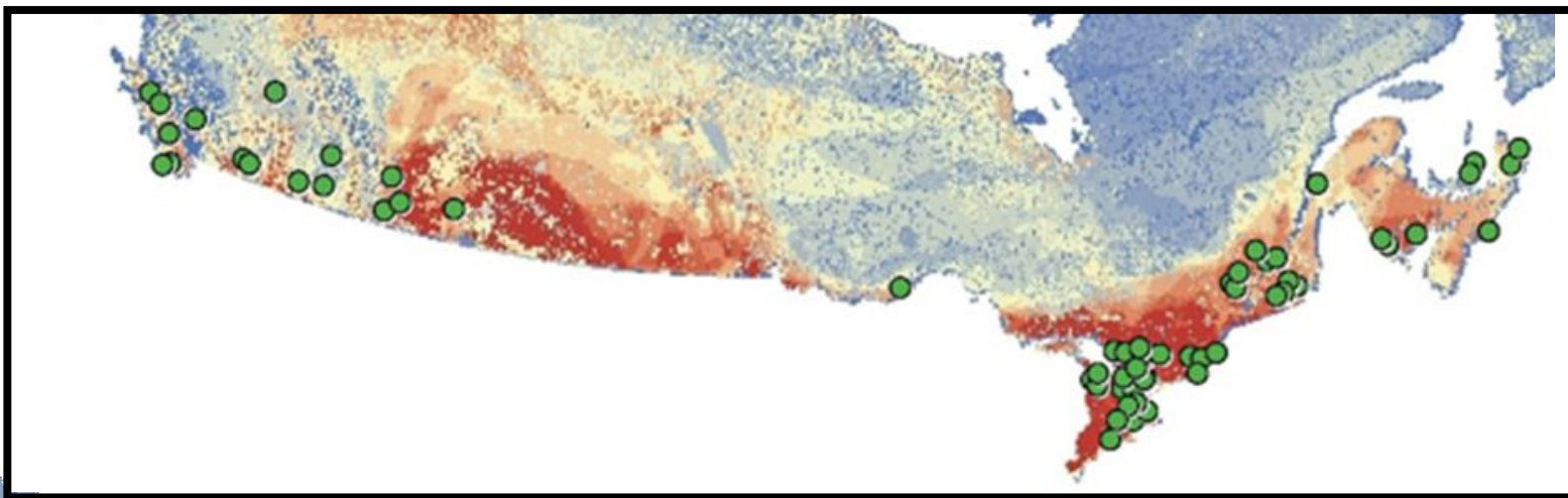
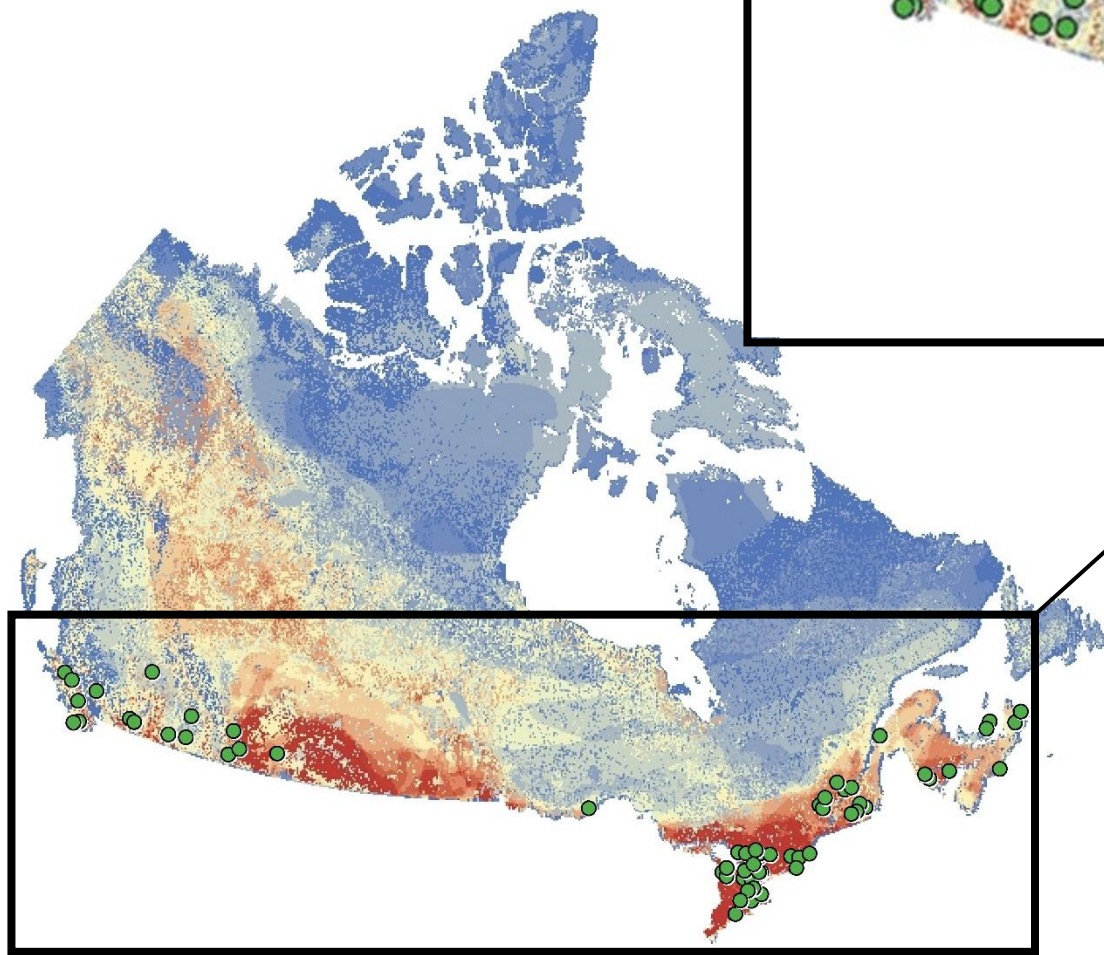
- Applicants must be a **Canadian land trust**;
- Applicants must be a **registered Canadian charity**;
- Applicants must have adopted and be in compliance with, or working towards substantial compliance with, the *Canadian Land Trusts Standards and Practices (2019)*; and,
- Applicants must demonstrate a **minimum of 1.5:1 in match funding** raised from sources other than Canadian Federal Government investments.
- Projects must count towards Canada Target 1

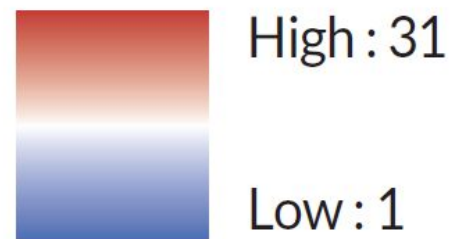




LTCF Supports Projects in Key SAR Areas

NHCP-LTCF – Beyond 2022-2023

- WHC is hoping that there will be an additional three years of funding that supports the LTCF (2023-2026)
- Available funding, hectare/match targets and parameters would likely be very similar to the program to date
- Efforts will be made, wherever possible, to streamline the program processes and improve program accessibility for land trusts
- WHC is looking at a tentative launch of NHCP- LTCF 2023-2026 in early 2023. Land trusts, please think about projects now and refer to current program guidelines for application prep.
